A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

The Board is very happy to announce that we will be starting the process of getting new roofs put on our properties. The work will be done by Owens Construction starting on or around January 18th, and will take 3-5 days per building, weather permitting. The 100, 500, and 700 buildings will not be replaced because they had the roofs done recently.

Due to the hail damage some five years ago, SRCA filed a claim for damage done to the roofs. After years of waiting and wondering, we finally got the answer we were hoping for insurance <u>will cover</u> the damage. It should be mentioned that the perseverance and diligence of our own Ron Biroschak was instrumental in us receiving the good news. He stayed on top of this issue even though he is not a current Board member. THANK YOU RON!

We can expect some noise and all the small inconveniences that come with doing a major construction project. We ask for your patience and ask that everyone avoids disrupting the workers.
